This is a joint program offered by Southwest Wisconsin Technical College and Boscobel High School

FREE to Enrolled students or students who live within the Boscobel District.

Students who are 14 years of age or older are eligible to enroll in the classroom portion of Driver's Education, which includes 30 hours of mandatory attendance.

Students will not be excused from any classes except in the case of a documented emergency. Plan accordingly.

In Person-Driver Education Theory Program Requirements:

1. Create a student account using the SWTC Continuing Education site: <https://swtc.augusoft.net>.

Student information and email must be for the student taking the class.

If you need help, there is a Need help link on the left side of the continuing education website.

- a. Student must register before the first day of class.
- b. Login to the continuing education student account
- c. Use the link provided to register for the class with your school. Pick one session.

2. Once you have completed and passed the Driver Education Theory, your instructor will provide a behind-the-wheel link.
