If your student cannot make the whole session, we still encourage them to come on days they are available!

Session One: These are enrichment sessions where students can sign up for classes. The dates for this session are **June 9-20 from 8:30-11:30 Monday – Friday**. Students in grades 2-5 will attend three different classes daily for an hour. Students in K-1 will attend one class for the whole time.

Middle School Running Fundamentals & Training: This session will focus on running skills and games for students in grades 5-7. Students will go on fun runs, tempo runs, and can expect games and/or scavenger hunts. The dates for this session are **June 16 - August 13 from 9:00-10:00 AM Monday and Wednesday**. Students will meet outside at the HS bus pick up rain or shine.

Volleyball Fundamentals & Training: This session will focus on volleyball skills and fundamentals for grades 5-8 and will be held at the high school's big gym. The dates for this session are **July 21-23, July 28-30, and August 4-6**. Times are based on the current grade level.

Basketball Skills & Fundamentals: This session will focus on basketball fundamentals for grades K-11 and will be held at the high school's big gym. The dates for this session are **June 23-25, June 30 - July 2, July 7-10, & July 14 - 17**. Times are based on grade level.

Football Skills & Fundamentals: This session will focus on football fundamentals for students currently in grades K-8 and will be held at the high school practice field by the weight room. The dates for this session are **July 7-10**. Times are based on grade level.

Dance Skills & Fundamentals: This session will explore the fundamentals of dance through stretching, learning basic leaps and turns, and mastering an energetic routine. Students will have fun while discovering the joy of dance in a lively summer setting! This session will be held at the high school cafeteria. The dates for this session are **June 23, 25, 30, July 2, 7, & 9 on Monday and Wednesday**. Times are based on grade level.

Beginner Band: This session will introduce students in grade 5 to playing and taking care of their instruments in groups of like instruments. On Friday students will rehearse together and put on an informal performance showing what they've learned. The dates for this session are **August 11-15**. Times are dependent on the instrument.

Summer Adventures: In this session, students will take field trips to children's museums, a zoo, parks, and a library. See the registration form for dates and activities.
