Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Grant County Health Department will be giving influenza vaccine at your child's school on **Tuesday, October 10th**. The influenza vaccine is **free for children 18 and under**. If you do not want your child to receive the influenza vaccine, do not return the consent form to the school.

Please note: Your child must be able to sit on a chair independently to receive the vaccine. To keep everyone safe, we will not administer the vaccine to a combative child. If your child needs a parent/caregiver present to comfort in order to receive the vaccine, please accompany your child. Additionally, your child could also receive the influenza vaccine at the Health Department.

To have your child receive the immunization at school:

Fill out the consent form for your child and return it to the school.

***If your child is 9 years and under and has never had influenza vaccine before, they need two doses of influenza vaccine. We will be going to the school only once, so if your child needs a second dose, please contact the Health Department for options or your own medical provider. There must be 4 weeks between the first and second dose.*
