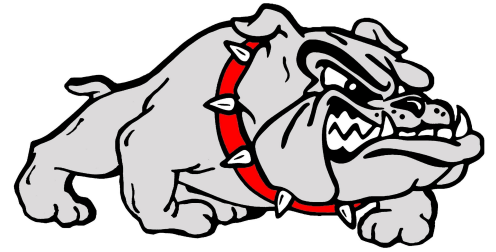


Middle/High School Summer School 2023

Dear Families,

If your child requires an emergency rescue medication to participate in summer school, you must complete the Medication Authorization Form. If your child has an emergency rescue medication consent on file at school that does not expire at the end of the current school year, please notify the school nurse by June 2, 2023. Otherwise, you will need to complete the Medication Authorization Form in order to send the rescue/emergency medication to summer school.

Note that as per usual, no medications are provided by the school. Medications must be in the original packaging with proper label and must be dosed according to label instructions for age. All prescription medications must also have the practitioner's signature. If medications are sent to school without the proper authorization/signatures, they will be returned home. We are not able to administer medications that are not properly and accurately labeled in the original packaging, are not dosed according to package instructions, are expired, or are missing the proper authorization/consent.

If your student will be outdoors and you wish to apply bug repellent or sunscreen, please do so prior to sending them to summer school programs.
