Dear Parent/Guardian

The Grant County Health Department will be at your child's school giving;

- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) vaccine [Required – 1 dose at 7<sup>th</sup> grade]
- Meningitis vaccine [Required – 2 dose series]  
First dose: 7<sup>th</sup> grade  
Second (booster) dose: 12<sup>th</sup> grade (a second dose is not required for students who received their first dose at age 16 or older)
- HPV (Human Papillomavirus) vaccine [Recommended – 2 or 3 dose series]

All school aged children in 4K through 12<sup>th</sup> grade:

- Influenza Vaccine [Recommended 1 dose seasonally]

**Boscobel Schools is scheduled for Tuesday, October 15th.**

The vaccines are free for all children 18 and under during this clinic only.

**If you would like your child to receive any of these vaccines at school:**

Fill out the consent form for your child and return it to the school by Monday, October 14th.
