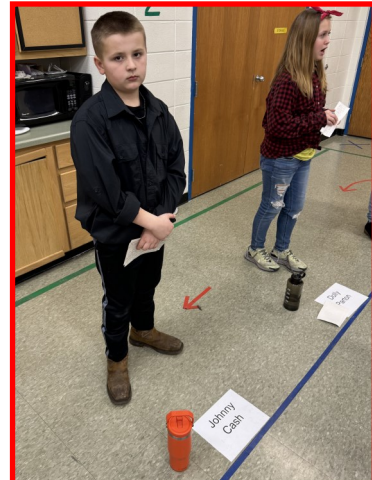
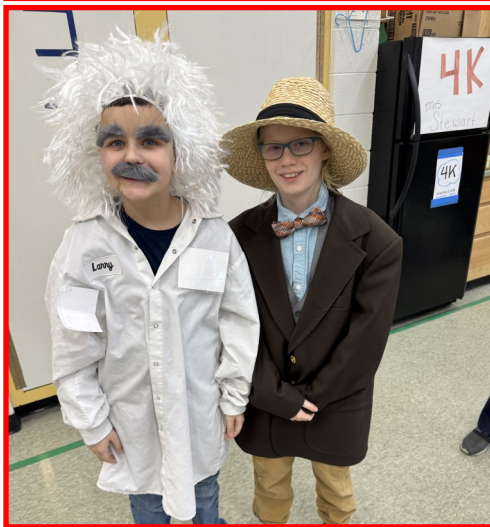
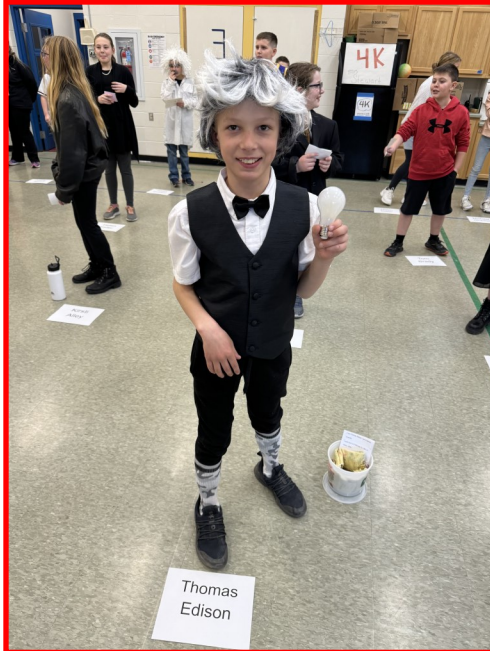
Successful Blood Drive!

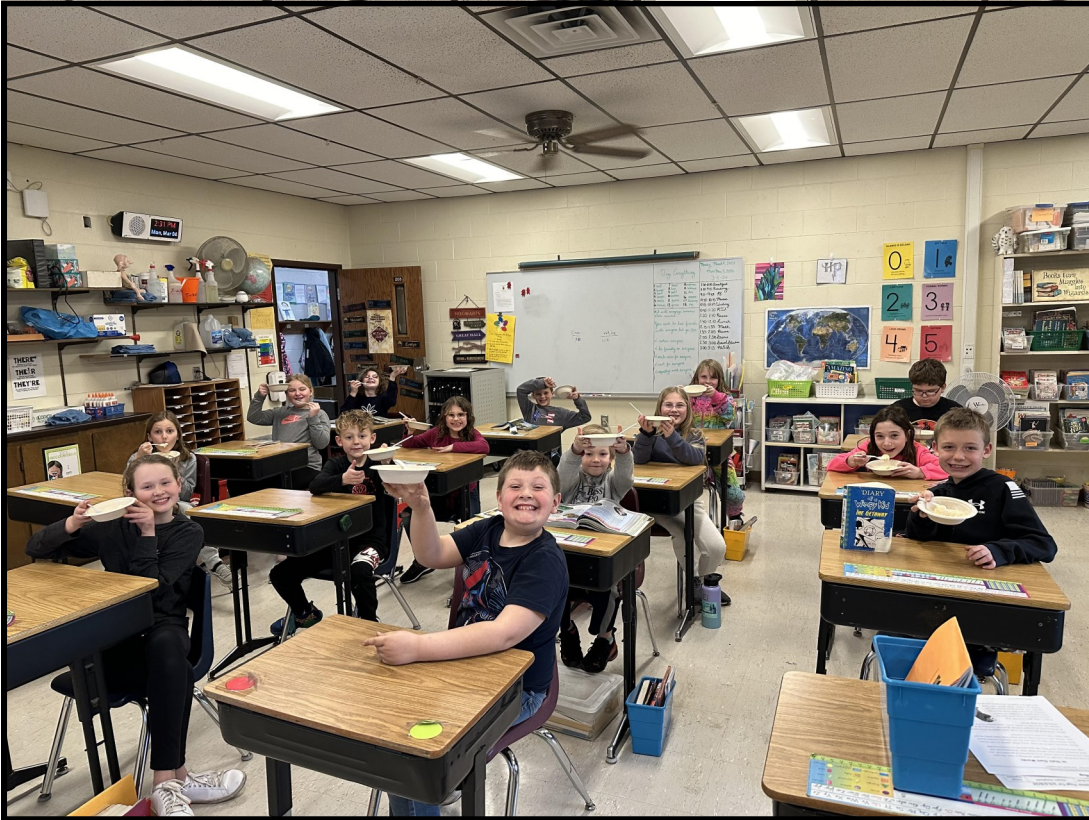

Mrs. French's foods class did an egg-speriment on what makes the best scrambled eggs. Moist, fluffy, and flavorful.





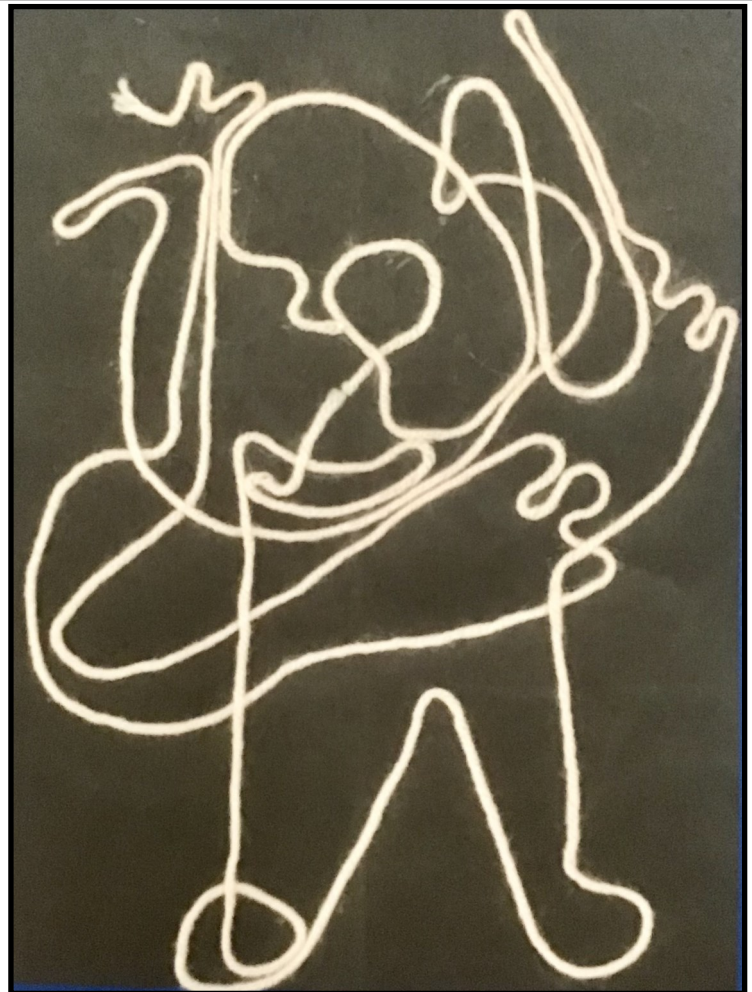
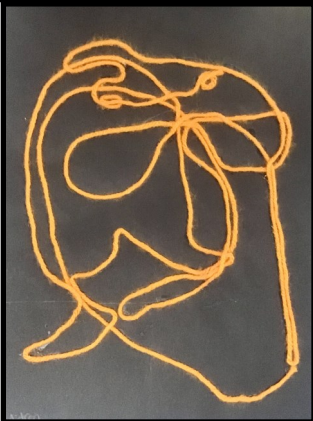
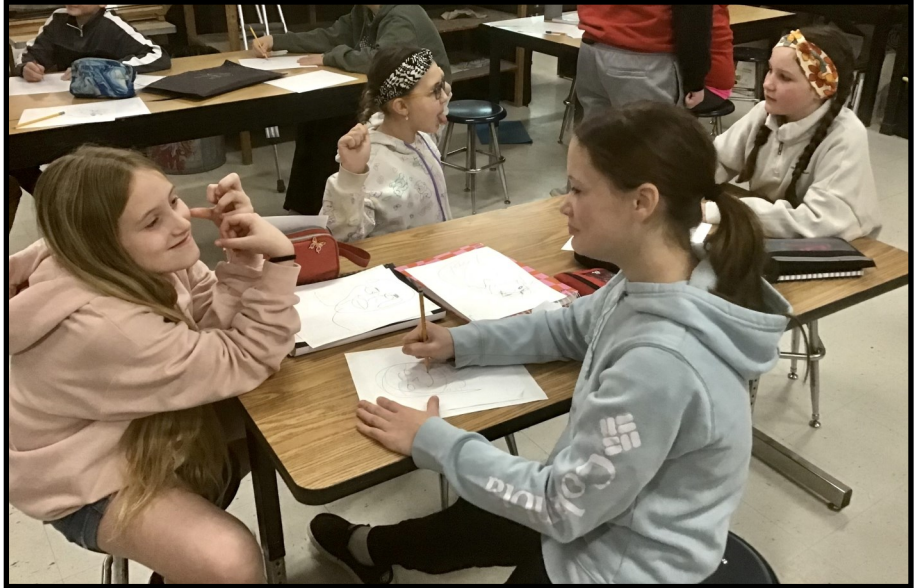

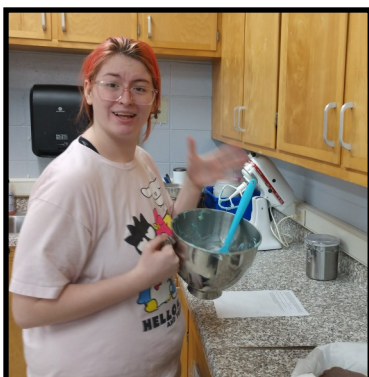
Coffee Shop Adventure to Wisconsin Dells
